On the second day twelve bulls from the herd, two rams, fourteen male lambs a year old without blemish... also one male goat for a sin offering... On the third day eleven bulls, two rams, fourteen male lambs a year old without blemish... On the fourth day ten bulls, two rams, fourteen male lambs a year old without blemish... On the fifth day nine bulls, two rams, fourteen male lambs a year old without blemish... “On the sixth day eight bulls, two rams, fourteen male lambs a year old without blemish... On the seventh day seven bulls, two rams, fourteen male lambs a year old without blemish... On the eighth day you shall have a solemn assembly. You shall not do any ordinary work, but you shall offer a burnt offering, a food offering, with a pleasing aroma to the Lord: one bull, one ram, seven male lambs a year old without blemish... These you shall offer to the Lord at your appointed feasts, in addition to your vow offerings and your freewill offerings, for your burnt offerings, and for your grain offerings, and for your drink offerings, and for your peace offerings.
